

## Question Generator Form with Sample Research Questions

Use this form to develop questions to guide your research. When developing your questions keep in mind:

- Questions starting with **who, what, where, when and why** from the column on the left in combination with the words in the top row, **are, do, would, can, and could**, are fairly easy to develop.
- Questions starting with **how and which** from the column on the left, in combination with the words **would, will and might** from the top row on the far right, are harder to develop, but lead to more in-depth research.
