

## Creating an Alert or an RSS Feed from a Google Search

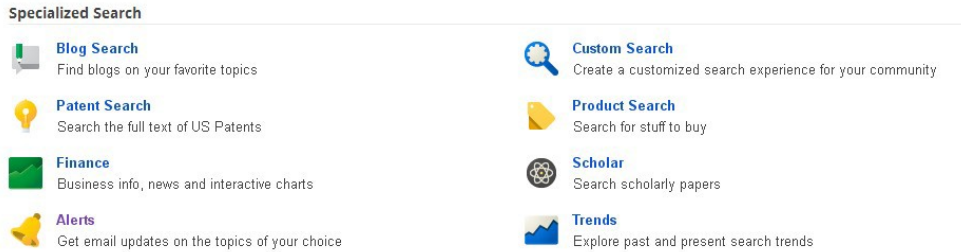
To create an alert or an RSS feed from a Google search

1. Sign into your Google Account.
2. Go to More from the menu at the top of the page



Pull down and choose *Even More* at the bottom of the page.

3. Choose *Alerts* under *Specialized Search* toward the bottom of the page.



4. Enter your search terms, choose the type of results you want and how often you want Google to send you the results, then choose from email or pull down to choose feed. If you are logged into your Google and have Google Reader already set up, the feed will automatically go to Reader. If you choose email, new information will be delivered to your email as it comes out.

5. If you want to modify the way you receive your alert, click on Manage your Alerts (see above). Then choose edit and make the changes you want.
