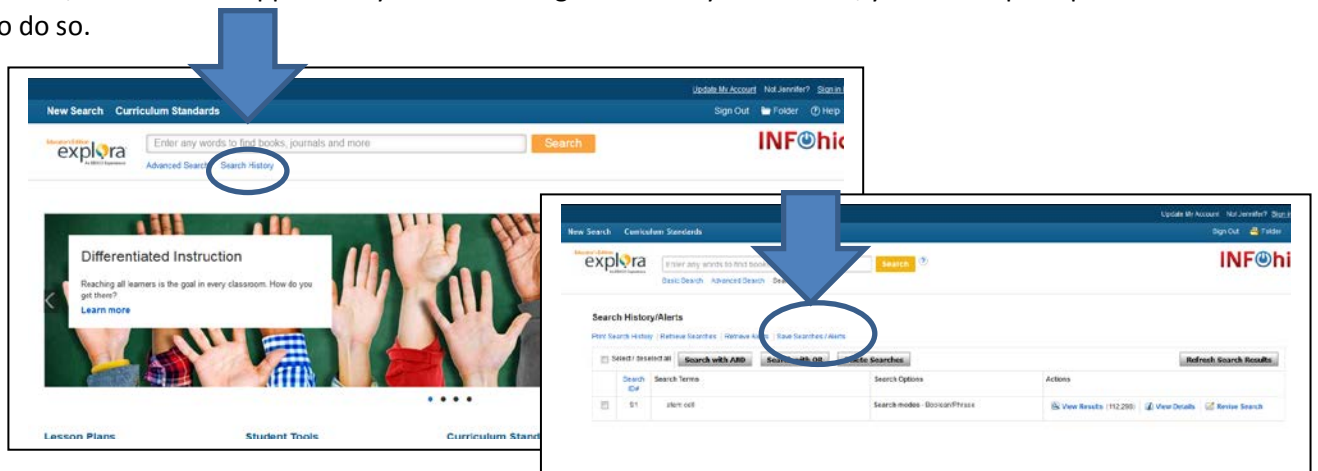


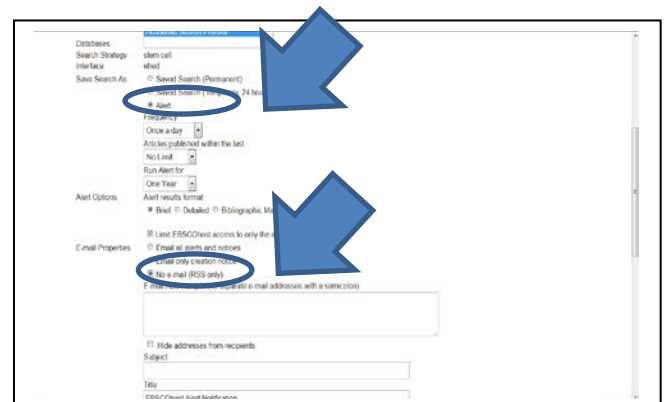
## Setting up an RSS Feed from EBSCO

In setting up an Alert in RSS Feeds, it is important to have a topic that is current. If you are interested in getting articles on a topic like the American Civil War, you might not get very many new articles posted. Remember you will only get the new articles as they come out in magazines.

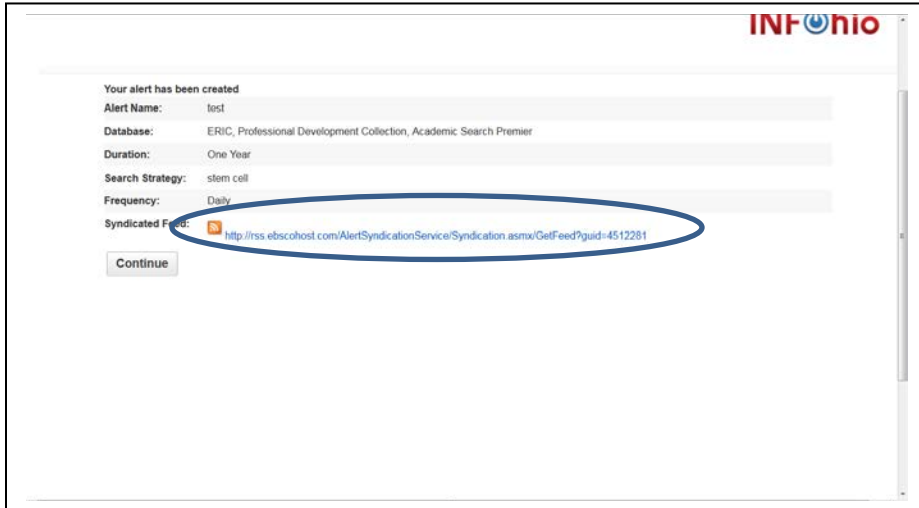
1. First go into EBSCO Explora or EBSCO Academic Search Premier in and do a search. Using the Advanced Search feature, refine your search by narrowing it down, if you are getting some resources that are not what you want. Also, use the Advanced Search to expand your search to get more of the types of articles you want.
2. Click the **Search History** link, then click the **Save Searches/Alerts** link. The Saved Search/Alerts Screen appears. If you have not signed in to My EBSCOhost, you will be prompted to do so.



3. Enter a **Name** and **Description** for the search. (For example, *mysearch1*)
4. In the **Save Search As** field, select Alert:
5. To save the search, click **Save**; otherwise, click **Cancel**. You are returned to the Search History/Alerts Screen.
6. Select **NO** email RSS Only
7. Press **SAVE**



8. Copy the link beside Syndication Feed circled in the next screen and then click on Continue.



9. Now all you have to do is place the syndication feed in your favorite RSS reader to get all of the latest information on your search. If you do not have an RSS reader, Feedly is an easy one to use <<http://feedly.com>>
