

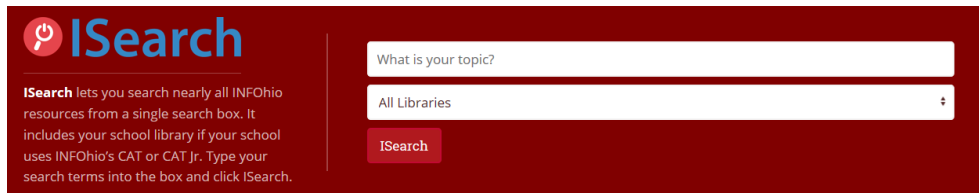

Searching with ISearch

1. **Log in to INFOhio website, select ISearch**
 - a. **Automatic login on school network**
 - b. **Username/password for home access**

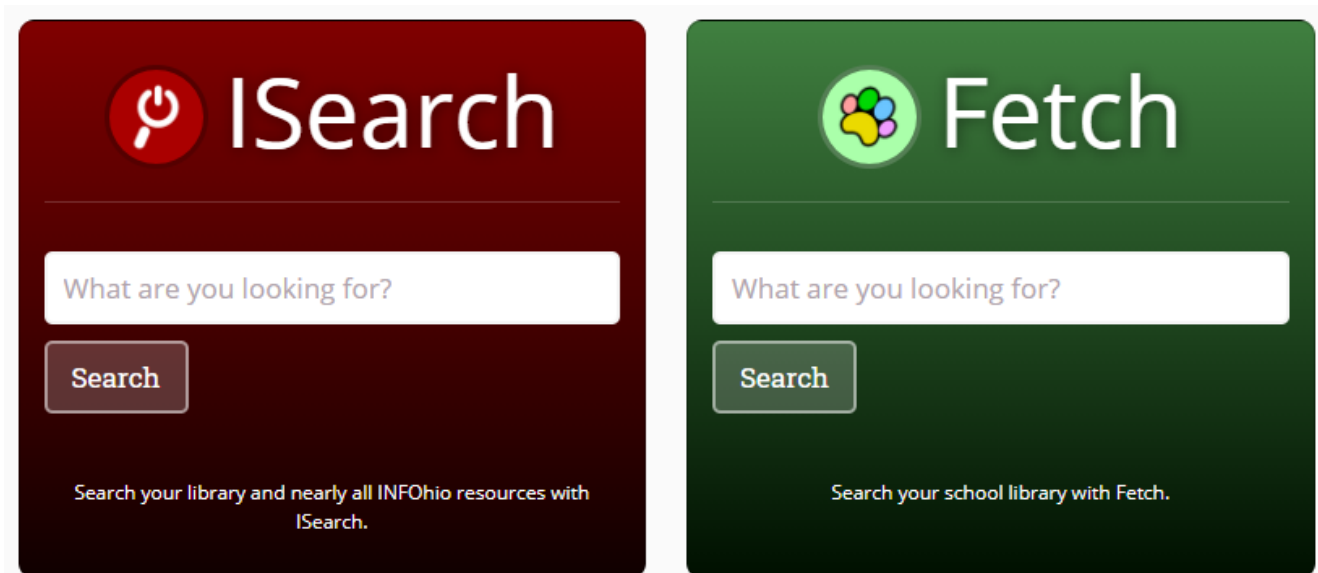

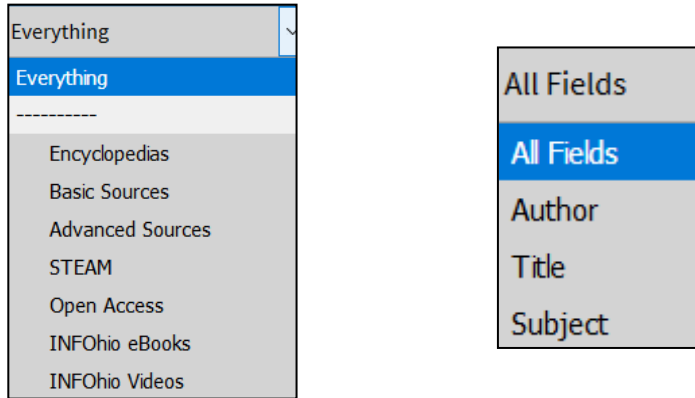

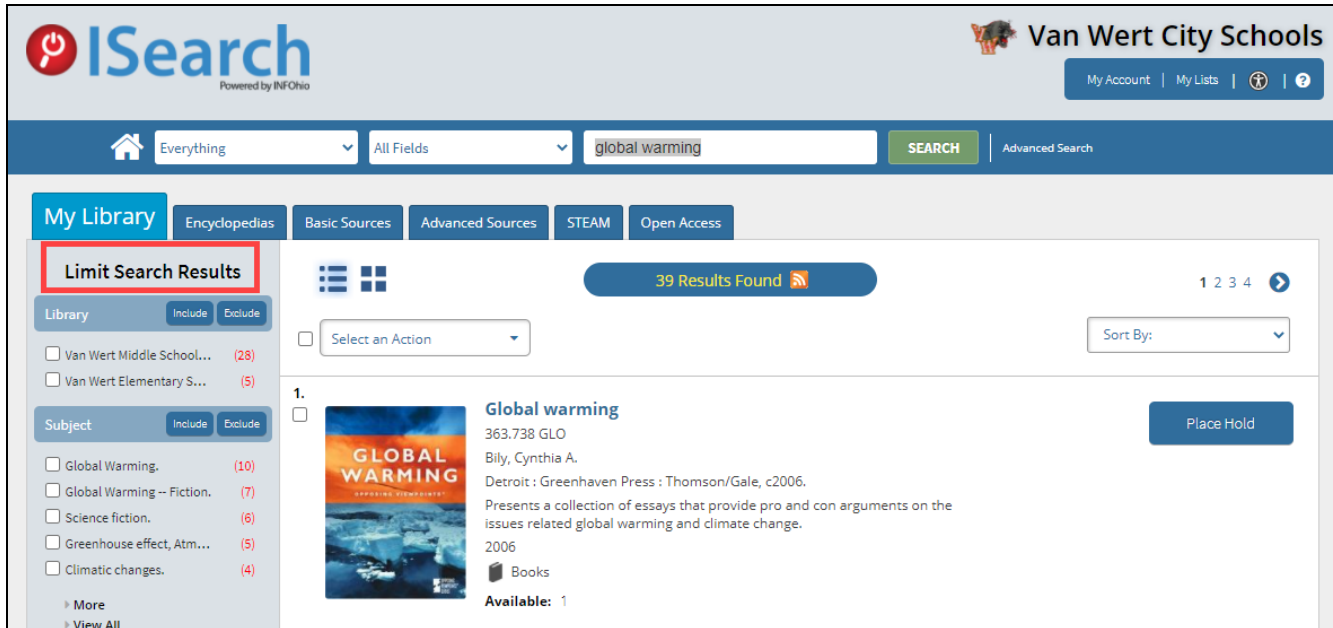
Enter search "What are you looking for?"

2. **Filters** in left column – for each SOURCE, can limit or expand results.




Example: MY LIBRARY source (select from Library, Subject, Author, Format, Item Group, Lexile, etc).

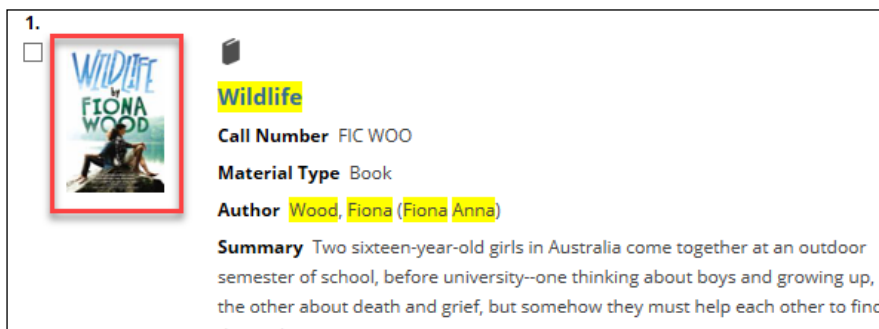
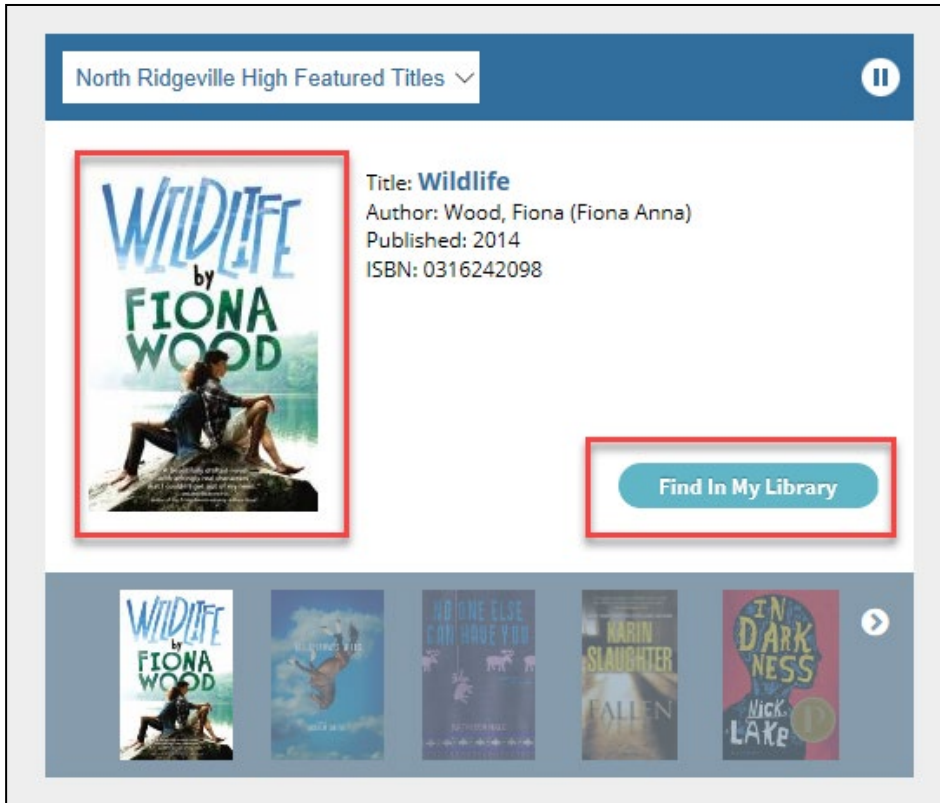
